

POLICY FOR TICKETS ISSUED AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2010

Excess charge rates shown in the two tables below have to be considered with the following currencies: EUR or equivalent from Europe, East Europe, Japan; USD from USA and South America; CAD or equivalent from Canada.

EQUIPMENT INCLUDED IN THE ALLOWANCE

The following items are considered checked-in baggage, and for this reason they are included in the baggage allowance. If they exceed the allowance, but always within a maximum of 23 Kgs. per item, they can be checked-in with the payment of an extra charge, according to the destination chosen:

	Italy	Europe, East Europe, North Africa, Middle East	Japan and China	North America, Canada, South America, Central Africa
Ski, (1 pair skis, poles, boots) Snowboard	20	20	40	40
Water ski, fishing/scuba diving equipment, Golf/polo bags, Bicycles/surf <107 Cm	30	30	60	60

We remind you that Golf equipment is always free of charge if within 23 Kgs of the allowance.

EQUIPMENT NOT INCLUDED IN THE ALLOWANCE

The following equipments are never included in the baggage allowance. They must be checked-in with the payment of an extra charge, according to the destination chosen, and they never can exceed 23 Kgs:

	Italy	Europe, East Europe, North Africa, Middle East	Japan and China	North America, Canada, South America, Central Africa
Surf/Kite surf <250 cm	50	70	130	130
Windsurf >250 cm	80	100	160	160

The excess charge rates have to be considered per single flight segment.
